



# Medical Certificate for Examinations

## Certificate

- > This certificate must be completed by a Registered Medical/Dental Practitioner or Specialist; or Registered Psychologist for any student who fails to sit an examination on medical grounds.
- > Consultation must occur on the day of the first examination missed.
- > Any other medical certificate will not be accepted.
- > The FSP/DTB student must submit this certificate to the Manager Student Services within 7 days of the exam.

**Please note that ailments such as colds and minor respiratory infections are not usually considered sufficient grounds for being unfit to sit an examination.**
