What is a University pathway?

A university pathway is an academic program that you can take before enrolling at university. It is designed to meet the needs of international students who do not meet the academic and/or English requirements for entry into our undergraduate or postgraduate coursework programs.

What do pathways include?

Is online learning available for offshore students?

In the current environment, classes will continue to be offered both face to face and online, allowing students to get a head start on their path towards University study, no matter where they are located.
