Bradford College Under 18 year old Student Management Plan

Many students studying at Bradford College are under the age of 18, and the College acts as these students' official care-givers. Bradford College takes special care and interest in the welfare of Under 18 students and as such we have a special policy to ensure their wellbeing.

Our Under 18 Student Management Plan includes:

- meeting with Under 18 students on a fortnightly basis and reporting back to the College Director and parents after these meetings
- regularly checking attendance and the academic performance of these students
- closely monitoring the accommodation situation of each student
- visiting/contacting each homestay/hostel with students under the age of 18 regularly to ensure that the accommodation is suitable
- providing one-to-one (individual) counselling by Student Services Manager.

Students who are under the age of 18 and who organise their own accommodation must comply with the following rules:

- 1. The person they will be living with MUST be over the age of 21 and they will need to show proof of age to Bradford College.
- 2. Both the Department of Immigration and Border Protection and Bradford College do not approve students to live with other students. We require it to be a blood relative: mother, father, grandparents, aunt or uncle, brother, sister or cousin (ONLY if they are over 21).
- 3. Family friends have to be registered as a homestay and also meet all the requirements below.

Bradford College will visit all accommodation for Under 18 students to:

- 1. determine that the living conditions are of an acceptable standard
- 2. assess whether the designated caregiver will provide a safe physical and emotional environment for the student
- 3. determine that the accommodation is not a boarding establishment
- 4. meet the designated caregiver and establish communication with the caregiver
- 5. ensure that we hold at all times personal contact information for all residential caregivers including:
 - full name current occupation
 - current police check relationship to student
 - current address and contact phone numbers
