Course books and materials fee will vary depending on program duration and subjects studied but can be expected to be approximately \$500-700 for the Foundation Studies or Degree Transfer Programs.



Payment

Tuition fees are normally payable over two or three instalments depending on the program of study. All instalments are payable before the commencement of the semester unless the student withdraws prior to the commencement of the program.

First instalment is usually the first semester fees plus additional fees as set out below, payable on acceptance of the offer.

Second and third instalments are comprised of the remainder of the tuition fees as appropriate to the program of study, payable before the commencement of the respective semester.
