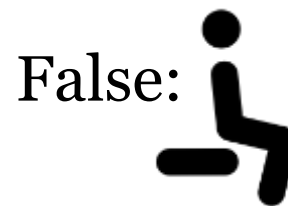
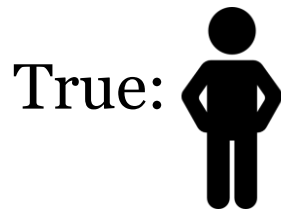

After you send this picture, your 'friend' tells you they will share it on the internet if you do not pay them AUD\$5,000.

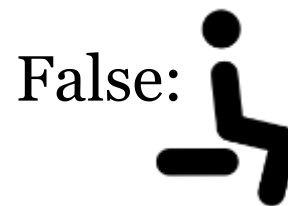
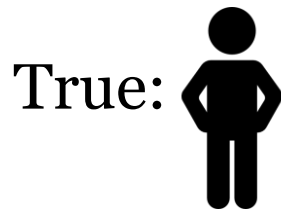


# True or False?

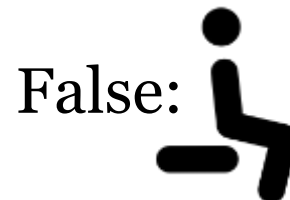
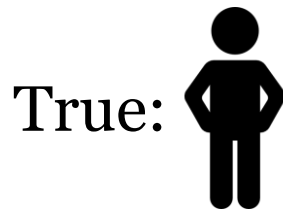


# True or False?

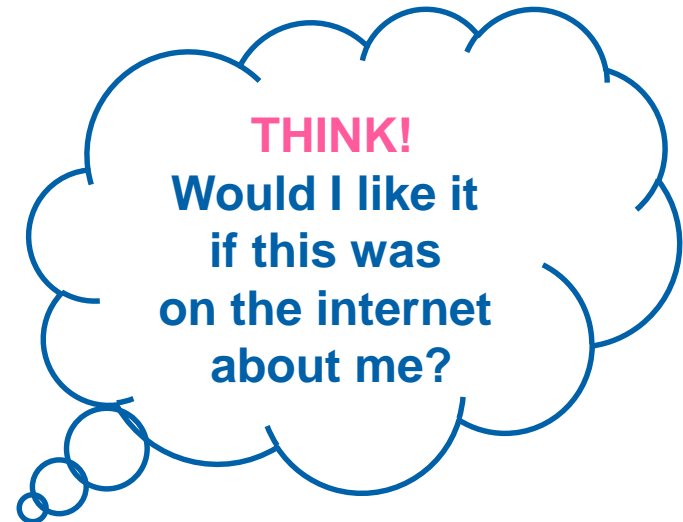

A dishonest and illegal activity to get money from you!

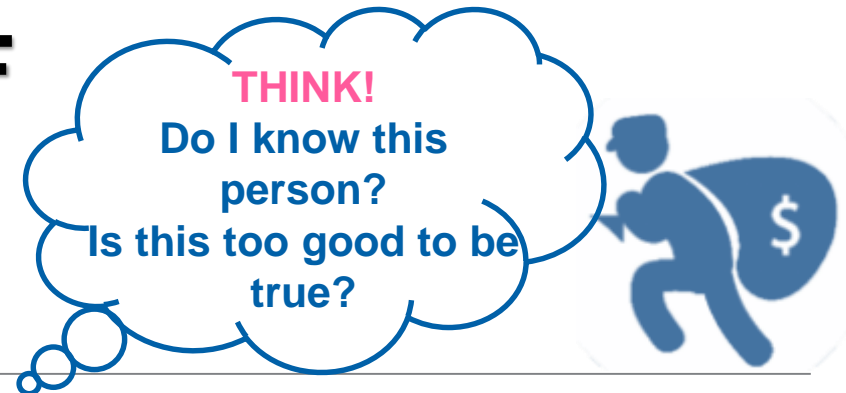
Students have lost AUD\$15,000+

Method – phone, email, text messaging

### Types

- Threats (“If you don’t pay we will do ...”)
- Dating (“Send me a picture. If you don’t give me money I will share it.”)
- Exchange rates (“If you send money, I’ll give you a good exchange rate”)
- Unexpected winnings (“You have won \$10K!!!”)
