You could receive a message from a very attractive person wanting to be your 'friend'.

After you make friends this person asks you for a private picture of you.

After you send this picture, your 'friend' tells you they will share it on the internet if you do not pay them AUD\$5,000.

A 'friend' offers you a really good exchange rate on your money to pay your school fees.

After you send them your money to pay your fees you receive a reminder from the school that your fess are not paid.


You try to contact your 'friend' to ask them about your fees being paid but you can't find them.



Your government contacts you to say that you are in big trouble and that your visa will be cancelled and you must return home.

If you do not pay the 'fee' of AUD\$15,000 you and your family will be in trouble.

You don't pay the money and nothing happens.



You get a new boy or girlfriend. It's great but after a while you decide you don't want to be with them.

When you try to break up with them they tell you that you have to keep sleeping with them or they will share pictures of you.

You report this to Student Services at the College and they help you understand your rights and what you can do to get out of this situation unharmed.

### **SCAMS**

A dishonest and illegal activity to get money from you!

Students have lost AUD\$15,000+ Method – phone, email, text messaging

Types

- Threats ("If you don't pay we will do ...")
- Dating ("Send me a picture. If you don't give me money I will share it.")
- Exchange rates ("If you send money, I'll give you a good exchange rate")
- Unexpected winnings ("You have won \$10K!!!")
