



## 2021 THE UNIVERSITY OF ADELAIDE COLLEGE FEES

### When will the 2021 fees be applied?

All applications for 2021 commencements received on and after 14 December 2020 will be subject to 2021 fees. The date an application is received will determine which fees the student will be charged.

Students issued with conditional offers before 14 December 2020 will be eligible for 2020 fees, even if they provide evidence that they have satisfied the required conditions on or after 14 December 2020.

Students with a valid offer for 2021 commencement with 2020 fees requesting a deferral to a later intake, or making any change to their offer, will be charged 2021 fees when the new offer letter is processed.

### Which additional fees are mandatory?

All students are required to pay the 'Enrolment Fee' and 'Facilities Fee' on acceptance of their offer.

Students who are required to, or have requested to, study English for Academic Purposes (EAP) will be required to pay the first instalment of their EAP Fees and the 'Books and Materials Fee' as detailed in their offer letter. These fees are required upon acceptance of their offer.

Students who are under 18 years of age and require the University of Adelaide College to act as a guardian, will have to pay the 'Guardianship Fees' as detailed in their offer letter.

Students who have been accepted in to the Foundation Studies Music Program will be required to pay the 'Music Tutorial Fee' as detailed in their offer letter.

The 'OSHC Fee' is only required if a student would like the University of Adelaide College to arrange health cover on their behalf for the duration of their student visa. If the student does not require the College to organise their OSHC, they will need to provide a verification letter at the time of acceptance, from their preferred health cover provider which includes the OSHC start and end dates. The OSHC dates must commence 1 month before the student's EAP or FSP/DT/PMP start date and continue on for 3 months after the bachelor's degree end date.

The 'Accommodation Fee' and 'Airport Pickup Fee' are optional fees that a student can elect to pay if they would like to receive these services.

### What is the Facilities Fee?

The Facilities Fee is mandatory for all students studying at the University of Adelaide College. It relates to access to the University's library and to other University of Adelaide services which all students require throughout their program [Foundation Studies (FSP), Degree Transfer Program (DT) and Pre-Masters Program (PMP)] including access to University of Adelaide's IT systems (both at the University of Adelaide College and on the University campus), a Student Card and University email address.

### What are subsequent semester/trimester fees?

Students need to pay second and third semester/trimester (if applicable) tuition fees before the commencement of the respective semester/trimester. If a student enrolled with 2020 fees with the study commencement in 2021 then the subsequent semester fees still remains the same as 2020 fees.

Students who enroll with 2020 fees and commence in 2021 continue to pay 2020 fees for their subsequent semesters.

Please note that these fees are subject to change. The University of Adelaide College reserves the right to change fees due to tax increases, governmental actions or other events beyond the University of Adelaide College's control.

### How much will be charged for books and materials while studying English for Academic Purposes?

The fees charged for English for Academic Purposes (EAP) books and materials will be determined by the number of weeks a student is enrolled in the EAP program. Student will be charged \$18 per week (maximum \$360).

The EAP books and materials fee must be paid at the time of acceptance.

### Which students will be charged the Guardianship fees?

The Guardianship fees are a mandatory payment for any student who is under 18 years of age upon commencement of their University of Adelaide College program and who wants the University of Adelaide College to assume guardianship rights until their 18th birthday.

Under 18 students who elect to stay with relatives (subject to the University of Adelaide College approval) will not be charged the Guardianship fees.

The \$310 administrative fee is a one-off fee that is payable on acceptance of the offer. \$55 per week will be charged by the University of Adelaide College until the student turns 18. Guardianship fees must be paid at the time of acceptance for the University of Adelaide College programs.
