When you complete your study in the Foundation Studies Program you will progress to the Degree Transfer Program, and with successful completion you will be eligible to enter into the second year of your bachelor's degree at the University of Adelaide, Melbourne Campus.

To complete your Foundation Studies Program and progress into the Degree Transfer Program, you will need to study one or two modules of English for Academic Purposes and Critical Thinking each trimester, and three other subjects for two trimesters each, across the three trimester program. College staff will assist you to ensure you have enrolled in the correct combination of subjects.




