# Degree Transfer Bridging Guidelines to Proceed to Degree Transfer

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## Introduction

This document details the requirements to pass the Bridging semester of the Degree Transfer Extended program to allow students to progress to the subsequent Degree Transfer Standard program.

## Criteria

<p><u>Business Stream</u></p> <p>Commerce/ Finance/ Economics</p>	<p>Pass 4 courses</p> <p>Or</p> <p>Pass 3 courses with the 4<sup>th</sup> ≥ 45% &amp; 5<sup>th</sup> ≥ 40%</p>
<p><u>Engineering Stream</u></p> <p>Engineering/ Computer Science</p>	<p>Pass 4 courses</p> <p>Or</p> <p>Pass 3 courses with the 4<sup>th</sup> ≥ 45% &amp; 5<sup>th</sup> ≥ 40%</p> <p>Students who fail either Engineering or Core Maths may be required to transfer to the business stream in consultation with the teacher in charge and academic manager</p>
<p><u>Science Stream</u></p> <p>Science/ Health and Medical Sciences</p>	<p>Pass 4 courses</p> <p>Or</p> <p>Pass 3 courses with the 4<sup>th</sup> ≥ 45% &amp; 5<sup>th</sup> ≥ 40%</p> <p>Students who fail Chemistry may be required to transfer to the business stream or repeat DTB in consultation with the teacher in charge and academic manager.</p>

Further criteria applicable to all streams:

1. Students are required to at least have an overall pass (average score ≥ 50%)

Where the above criteria has not been met:

- Course teacher input may be considered in determining the readiness of a student for undergraduate studies
- Consideration will be given to the importance of the failed courses to the student's subsequent studies when making pass/fail/transfer decisions

### Information regarding the number of attempts of Degree Transfer Bridging

- Students are permitted a maximum of two attempts at the Degree Transfer Bridging program
- Withdrawals after Week 6 (week 5 of class) will be considered as one attempt
