



Fees and Key Dates 2023 FAQs

When will the 2023 fees be applied?

All applications for 2023 commencements received on and after 1 September 2022 will be subject to 2023 fees. The date an application is received will determine which fees the student will be charged.

Students issued with conditional offers before 1 September 2022 will be eligible for 2022 fees, even if they provide evidence that they have satisfied the required conditions on or after 1 September 2022.

Students with a valid offer for 2023 commencement with 2022 fees requesting a deferral to a later intake, or making any change to their offer, will be charged 2023 fees when the new offer letter is processed.

Which additional fees are mandatory?

All students are required to pay the Enrolment Fee and Administration and Student Support Fee on acceptance of their offer.

Students who are required to, or have requested to, study General Academic English and/or English for Academic Purposes will be required to pay the first instalment of their English language program fees and the Books and Materials Fee as detailed in their offer letter. These fees are required upon acceptance of their offer.

Students who are under 18 years of age and require the University of Adelaide College to act as a guardian, will have to pay the Welfare Fees as detailed in their offer letter.

The Overseas Student Health Cover fee is only required if a student would like the University of Adelaide College to arrange health cover on their behalf for the duration of their student visa. If the student does not require the College to organise their Overseas Student Health Cover, they will need to provide a verification letter at the time of acceptance, from their preferred health cover

provider which includes the Overseas Student Health Cover start and end dates.

The Overseas Student Health Cover dates must commence one month before the student's English language program or Foundation Studies Program, Degree Transfer Program or Pre-Master's Program start date and continue on for three months after the bachelor's or master's degree end date.

The Accommodation Fee and Airport Pick-up Fee are optional fees that a student can elect to pay if they would like to receive these services.

What is the Administration and Student Support Fee?

The Administration and Student Support Fee is mandatory for all students studying at the University of Adelaide College at either the Adelaide Campus or Melbourne Campus. It relates to access to the University's library and to other University of Adelaide services which all students require throughout their pathway program including access to University of Adelaide's IT systems (both at the University of Adelaide College and on the University campus), a Student Card and University email address.

What are subsequent semester/trimester fees?

Students need to pay second and third semester/trimester (if applicable) tuition fees before the commencement of the respective semester/trimester. If a student enrolled with 2022 fees with the study commencement in 2023 then the subsequent semester fees still remains the same as 2022 fees.

Students who enroll with 2022 fees and commence in 2023 continue to pay 2022 fees for their subsequent semesters.

Please note that these fees are subject to change. The University of Adelaide College reserves the right to change fees due to tax increases, governmental actions or other events beyond the University of Adelaide College's control.

How much will be charged for books and materials while studying General Academic English and/or English for Academic Purposes?

The fees charged for books and materials will be determined by the number of weeks a student is enrolled in an English language program. Students will be charged \$18 per week (maximum \$360).

The General Academic English and/or English for Academic Purposes books and materials fee must be paid at the time of acceptance.

Which students will be charged the Welfare Fees?

The Welfare Fees are a mandatory payment for any student who is under 18 years of age upon commencement of their University of Adelaide College program and who wants the University of Adelaide College to assume guardianship rights until their eighteenth birthday.

Under 18 students who elect to stay with relatives (subject to the University of Adelaide College approval) will not be charged the Welfare Fees.

The \$330 administrative fee is a one-off fee that is payable on acceptance of the offer. \$60 per week will be charged by the University of Adelaide College until the student turns 18. Guardianship fees must be paid at the time of acceptance for the University of Adelaide College programs.
