Under 18 Welfare Arrangements Summary

Accommodation Options

Students under the age of 18 under the guardianship of the University of Adelaide College have the following accommodation options:

1. **The University of Adelaide College homestay**
2. **Scape at the University of Adelaide**
3. **Current homestay** (onshore students wishing to continue their current homestay arrangements must have this homestay approved by the University of Adelaide College)
4. **Living with family member or family friend** (this arrangement must be approved by the University of Adelaide College).

The University of Adelaide College homestay

- **Location:** 30 minutes to Adelaide CBD.
- **Residential Term(s):** Minimum stay discretion.
- **Accommodation Fee:** \$340 per week (subject to change).
- **Inclusions:** 2 meals a day (Weekdays Breakfast & Dinner), 3 meals per day (Weekends), Wifi (approx. \$5 per week), electricity, water, laundry, study desk, bed, lamp, family environment, English immersion.

In Homestay, students receive a uniquely Australian experience, living with a local family in their home.

Homestay is ideal for developing English language skills and assists students with adjusting to life in Australia by providing a family atmosphere.

Homestay providers are required to undertake an extensive interview and checking process, including police screening, and are required to be aware of, and sensitive to, the cultural needs of international students. Regular communication between the College and the Homestay provider is facilitated by the College Accommodation Manager.

As a way of settling in to the family, students may undertake some basic household tasks, such as doing dishes and preparing the table for dinner.

Students are required to stay with their homestay family until they turn 18 years of age. Once a student turns 18 years old, they are welcome to continue the arrangement with the prior to the exact moving date. Two weeks notice is required when choosing to leave your homestay.

Scape at the University of Adelaide

- **Location:** 230 North Terrace, Adelaide.
- **Residential Term(s):** Minimum one semester. As per agreement with Scape.
- **Accommodation Fee:** \$249-\$399 (various options available) (prices subject to change).
- **Inclusions:** Electricity, water, study desk, bed, lamp, bathroom, kitchen/lounge/laundry facilities, gym, 20GB of internet per month, contents insurance. Meals not included restaurants & supermarkets close by.

Scape at the University of Adelaide provides high quality state of the art purpose built student accommodation directly adjacent the University of Adelaide North Terrace campus and a short walk down Rundle Mall to the University of Adelaide College.

Students will benefit from the community environment and study spaces provided, shared with undergraduate and postgraduate students of the University. This facility is safe and secure with a 24/7 dedicated onsite team and swipe card access for the building and all rooms. Scape offers modern furnished rooms with bathroom and air conditioning right in the centre of Adelaide.

Under 18 students are grouped with members of the same gender, and are provided with additional monitoring and support to ensure their safety and welfare. Scape provides a comprehensive orientation and social program designed to support a successful transition into Australian and University life.

If a student turns 18 during their stay at Scape, they are required to stay for the remainder of their contract. Once a student turns 18 years of

age, they are welcome to extend their contract with Scape, or if they decide to move out, suitable notice must be given.

Welfare Monitoring

Welfare monitoring services are provided by the University of Adelaide College. The College and the University take special care and interest in the welfare of Under 18 student to ensure their wellbeing. The College's Under 18 Management and Monitoring of Under 18 Student policy and procedure includes:

- initial meeting with the Student Services Coordinator to confirm wellbeing, collect arrival pack, and receive information regarding health and security advice, general welfare, visa and ESOS compliance and settling into Adelaide
- fortnightly meetings with the Student Services Coordinator or teacher to monitor wellbeing, attendance and course progress with monthly reports to parents
- regular monitoring of accommodation arrangements to ensure suitability
- access to individual counselling with Student Services Coordinator
- process for approval and monitoring travel arrangements of Under 18 students returning to their home country or travelling during breaks
- curfew monitoring (students are required to be in approved accommodation by 10pm each night).
